RICHARD SIBBES

As we receive all from God, so we should lay all at his feet, and say, "I will not live in a course of sin that will not stand with the favour of my God." . . .

A man is in a sweet frame when his heart is made subject to God, and drawn out towards him, for the God of all grace sets it at liberty. Psalm 34 (ESV)

- 1 I will bless the LORD at all times; his praise shall continually be in my mouth.
